**Give your kids the gift of STEM over winter break
with Camp Curiosity at Great Lakes Science Center**

CLEVELAND (November 19, 2019) – Don't let your kids get frozen to the couch during their winter break from school this year! Bring them down to Camp Curiosity at Great Lakes Science Center for a hands-on day packed with interactive science camp activities!

Kicking off on Thursday, December 26, the Science Center has six different themes for kids in kindergarten through eighth grade to choose from, including LEGOs, robots, rockets, chemistry, engineering and physics! Camps run December 26, 27, 30, 31 and January 2, 3.

Campers can mix chemical concoctions, use LEGOs to explore the engineering behind carnivals, experiment with propulsion, play with polymers and more! All camps are separated by age, and camp activities are tailored for each age group. Your camper can choose one day of adventure, or do all six for a full-sized STEM winter break.

This year's camps include:

Robots on Mars – Thursday, December 26
Magical Matter – Friday, December 27
Space Camp: Beyond the Stars – Monday, December 30
Curious Chemistry – Tuesday, December 31
Engineering Re-imagined – Thursday, January 2
LEGO Carnival – Friday, January 3

Winter break camps are \$55 per day (\$50 for Science Center members) and run from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., with options for before-care from 7:30-8:30 a.m. and after-care from 3:30-5:30 p.m. for an additional fee. Sign up for all six days of camp and receive a \$30 discount. Boxed lunches are available for pre-order as well for \$7.50 each day.
